ABOUT THIS PROGRAM

Maine residents who have **BOTH** hearing and vision loss may be eligible for free adaptive communication equipment from the National Deaf Blind Equipment Distribution Program (NDBEDP), through Disability Rights Maine Deaf Services.

Funded by the Federal Communications Commission, the goal of the NDBEDP is to provide equal communication access to Deaf-Blind individuals by distributing equipment that will be used for telecommunications, accessing the internet, and advanced communications.

- ★ Computers, computer software, and computer accessories;
- ★ iPads and Android tablets;
- ★ Amplified and cellular telephones;
- ★ Refreshable Braille Displays, and more!
